

Letter 23: Before 13 February 1519, [Basel], Johannes Oecolampaius to Capito

The letter itself is lost. It is paraphrased by Beatus Rhenanus in a letter to Zwingli, printed in *Briefwechsel des Beatus Rhenanus*, ed. A. Horawitz and K. Hartfelder (Leipzig 1886; reprint 1966) p. 136.

[*Summary*]: Oecolampadius has written from Augsburg informing him that Luther was still in Wittenberg. He adds that Frederick III, elector of Saxony, has written a letter to Cardinal Cajetan on Luther's behalf.
