

Letter 33: 23 November 1519, Augsburg, Johannes Oecolampadius to Capito

[*Summary*]: Oecolampadius begins by expressing his delight in his friendship with Capito. He is sending him, along with this letter, a copy of Jodocus Textoris' *Christiani poenitentis confessio* in an effort to have the work reprinted either by Johann Froben or Andreas Cratander. If they are unwilling, he would like Capito to send it back to him because he could easily find other printers willing to undertake the task.
