

Letter 71: 16 January 1521, Ebernburg, Ulrich von Hutten to Capito

[*Summary*]: Franz von Sickingen has asked Capito to approach Albert of Brandenburg to help in the cause of Reuchlin. They have invited him to join them at the Ebernburg. Hutten is annoyed that Capito has not written to his friends in a while and inserts only brief messages to them in letters to others. He suggests that Capito is distancing himself from him.
