

Letter 75: 5 February 1521, [Wartburg?], Ulrich von Hutten to Capito

[*Summary*]: Bucer has not yet responded to Hutten's many letters that Capito was supposed to relay. [These letters are not extant]. Franz von Sickingen is annoyed that Bucer maintain contact with him. Hutten asks for clarification of Capito's recent statement that Hutten has not been excommunicated, nor should he be. Hutten is concerned about Albert's health. He asks Capito whether the rumour that Aleandro is a Jew is true or not. He also wonders how Luther is doing and wants to be kept informed about Bucer's case.
