

Letter 82: 3 March 1521, Augsburg, Bernhard Adelmann to Capito

[*Summary*]: Adelmann begs Capito to respond to his letters. Oecolampadius' *Iudicium de Luthero* is being circulated in Latin and in a German translation, but he does not know by whom. Johann Eck attempted to harass Oecolampadius on account of this. Oecolampadius is showing more determination than ever to resist him. Adelmann admires the erudition displayed in Oecolampadius' *Paradoxon, quod non sit onerosa christianis confessio*. He asks Capito to write back and to include information on Erasmus. Oecolampadius sends his regards.
