

Letter 84: 10 March 1521, Augsburg, Bernhard Adelman to Capito

[*Summary*]: Adelman is enclosing a letter he has received from Oecolampadius. The latter wanted Capito to know that Johann Eck has threatened the city council of Augsburg and Oecolampadius himself with excommunication unless they suppress the *Iudicium de Luthero*. Oecolampadius is concerned for his monastery's reputation [i.e. the Altomünster]. Adelman begs Capito to reassure Oecolampadius. In the postscript, Adelman adds that Oecolampadius apparently thinks that Capito circulated the *Iudicium* in order to free him from his monastic vows.
