

Letter 88: 30 March 1521, Augsburg, Bernhard Adelmann to Capito and Conrad Peutinger

[*Summary*]: Oecolampadius and Adelmann are wondering what happened to the [reading] glasses that Capito had promised. He asks Capito to send a pair to them by way of Peutinger, and Adelmann will cover the expense. Oecolampadius is annoyed that the daily routine at the Altomünster is impeding his studies and reading and blames himself for the troubles arising from his monastic vows. He asks for Capito's advice. Luther's case is in God's hands.
