

Letter 91: 13 April 1521, [Ebernburg], Franz von Sickingen to Capito

This letter has been printed by P. C. Molhuysen, "Een onuitgegeven brief von Frans von Sickingen," in NAKG 3 (1905): 93-95. The text is on pages 94-5.

[*Summary*]: Sickingen offers his services to Capito. He reports that Bernhard Spiegel's vicarage at the cathedral of Speyer is being claimed by the papal courtier Johann Rastoris. He feels sorry for Spiegel, who is supporting a mother and several sisters. He asks Capito to intercede on Spiegel's behalf, who is ready to appear before an unbiased judge. He suggests either the archbishop of Mainz or of Worms or the bishop of Speyer.
