Letter 133: 9 February 1522, Wittenberg, Felix Ulscenius to Capito

[Summary]: Ulscenius reports that Berlinus [unidentified] has praised Capito's sermons. Remboldus has heard that Capito will shortly depart for Nürnberg and asks for six gulden. He stands in great need of money and has no one from whom he could borrow. Justus Jonas is about to marry. The city council is acting in the interest of the Reformation. Melanchthon spoke out against an unnamed person who deliberately misinterprets I Kings 8:11. He may have had Capito in mind.
