

Letter 166: 6 September 1523, Sélestat, Jacob Wimpheling to Capito

[*Summary*]: The Alsatian humanist Jacob Wimpheling (1450-1528) relates rumours that Capito is preaching against the veneration of saints and cautions him to show respect for the teachings of the Church Fathers and to honour the memory of his teachers at Freiburg. He fears that the teachings of Matthew Zell and Martin Bucer will cause a public uproar and recommends that they and Capito examine their conscience.
