

Letter 186: 29 February 1524, Strasbourg, The City Council of Strasbourg to the Preachers

Printed in CorrBucer 1, pp. 220-222, Ep. 60.

[*Summary*]: The council is eager to avoid dissension and, in the circumstances, cannot at this time authorize a public discussion of doctrine. They demand that the preachers refrain from further liturgical innovation [such as saying the mass in German], observe in their preaching the mandate [of 1 December 1523], and keep the peace.
