

Letter 195: 4 May 1524, Basel, Andreas Cratander to Capito

Printed in BrOek 1, pp. 277-278, Ep. 193.

[*Summary*]: Oecolampadius returned to Basel from Weinsberg on 31 April. Cratander asks Capito to transmit to him in Basel any manuscripts he might have received from Oecolampadius. He furthermore asks him to send him the Hebrew characters through Wolfgang Köpfel. He needs them to print the Isaiah commentary. [Johannes] Zwick will tell him other news. Boniface Amerbach has just returned from Avignon [to take over the teaching of law from Claude Chansonette].
