

Letter 213: [Beginning of September 1524], from [Felix Ulscenius (?)] to Capito]

This letter was enclosed with Ep. 212. It is printed in *Willibald Pirckheimers Briefwechsel*, ed. H. Scheible (Munich, 2001) 5, pp. 244-245.

[*Summary*]: The parish priest of Siegolsheim was condemned to death in the court at Ensisheim and burned at the stake. He had confessed to the accusations under torture, then recanted them. He rejected the consolations of friends, saying he trusted in God. In the writer's opinion he was not given a fair trial.
