Letter 247: [c. 8 October 1525, Strasbourg], Capito and his colleagues to Martin Luther

[Summary]: The preachers of Strasbourg send Gregor Caselius<sup>1</sup> to present their views on the Sacramentarian controversy. The dissension among the reformers has been detrimental to the church in France, the Low Countries, and Germany. They ask Luther to give Caselius a friendly reception.

<sup>1</sup> Gregor Caselius (d. c. 1528) studied at Wittenberg and taught Hebrew at Strasbourg. Caselius returned from his mission after 5 November (the date of Luther's reply to the Strasburgers, entrusted to him, cf. below, Ep. 252a) and presented his report in Strasbourg c. 29 November (cf. CorrBucer 2, p. 71, Ep. 113).
