

Letter 251: [c. 5 November 1525], Wittenberg, Justus Jonas to Capito.

Printed in *CorrBucer 2*, Ep. 113, p. 72. This is a message from Jonas to Capito relayed by Gregor Caselius upon his return from Wittenberg. It runs: “Jonas to Capito: It is a great thing to be mortified and humiliated. I prefer to be an ignorant disciple of Luther than share in the fame of those men. He will write when there is an opportunity and wonders why Capito has not written to him.”
