

Letter 256: 14 November 1525, [Strasbourg], Capito to Ulrich Zwingli

[*Summary*]: He will see about the apothecary [see below, Ep. 258]. The Wittenbergers answered their request for advice [on the Sacramentarian question] with slanderous accusations. It is rumoured that [Albert of Brandenburg], the archbishop of Mainz, has married. Capito is pleased with Zwingli's response to Bugenhagen, although some pages were missing from the copy he sent. He hopes that the bookseller will send Zwingli's books to the printer Wolfgang Köpfel soon. He sends greetings to Myconius.
