

Letter 266: 20 December 1525, Zurich, Ulrich Zwingli to Capito

Printed in ZwBr 2, pp. 464-5, Ep. 423.

[*Summary*]: He sent Capito a letter on 18 December [lost] and is now answering the one he just received [Ep. 261]. Zwingli would like an opportunity to speak to the preachers of Strasbourg in person. Alternatively, he would like Capito to notify him if a trustworthy person should visit Zurich to whom he may speak openly. Letters are by no means safe, and he is reluctant to offer counsel. Zurich is at peace. According to Oecolampadius, this letter will safely reach Capito.
