

Letter 329a: [Before 14 April 1527, Strasbourg], Capito, Caspar Hedio, Matthew Zell and Martin Bucer to the City Council of Strasbourg

[*Summary*]: Meinolf von Andlau has nominated [Friedrich], the curate of Mittelbergheim, for the position of parish priest of Benfeld. Friedrich wishes to continue Catholic rites and lives with a concubine. The city council has to act in such a way that the gospel may continue to be preached in Benfeld. The parish must be allowed to ascertain that the new curate is willing to preach the gospel and marry his concubine. They furthermore have the right to ask Friedrich to come to Strasbourg for an examination. The preachers ask the council to give their attention to this matter.
