

Letter 349: 13 March 1528, Strasbourg, Capito to Ulrich Zwingli

[*Summary*]: [Paul Rasdorfer] came to Strasbourg from Augsburg and stayed for eight days. He was begun to learn the art of weaving and wishes to go to Zurich, where this craft is thriving. Capito recommends him to Zwingli. He holds the correct belief concerning the Eucharist. He is not highly educated, but firm in his faith. Johannes Hylactaeus, who recently came to Bern from Bavaria, attests to [Rasdorfer]'s reputation and renown as a preacher of the Word. The Strasbourg reformers cannot employ him. Perhaps he can be of use in Bern. Greetings to Zwingli's family and the Zurich reformers.
