

Letter 372: 19 November [1528], Basel, Johannes Oecolampadius to Capito and Martin Bucer

Printed in CorrBucer 3, p. 256, Ep. 617.

[*Summary*]: Oecolampadius was glad to welcome Jacob Sturm and his companions in Basel. Together they travelled on to Bern where they were well received. [They were to help in the negotiations between Bern and the rebels in the Oberland]. Capito's letter was brought by the Constance physician [Conrad Nyder?]. He fears the "feigned piety" of the Anabaptists.
