

Letter 381: 15 March 1529, [Strasbourg], Capito to Ulrich Zwingli

[*Summary*]: Capito has heard of Christopher's³ complaint against the Swiss confederacy. He alludes to the difficulties of the preachers in Strasbourg and the delegates at the Diet of Speyer. They will send [Johann] Mantel and [Melchior Ambach] when the former returns from Württemberg at Easter. The bearer of the letter will tell Zwingli whom they have in mind for Solothurn. He has dipped into Zwingli's commentary on Isaiah [*Complanatio Isaiae*, Zurich: Froschauer, 1529] and approves of it, but asks him not to neglect the Hebrew commentaries.
