

Letter 381a: [Middle to end of March 1529, Strasbourg], The Strasbourg Preachers to the City Council of Strasbourg

The text of this letter is in BDS 2, pp. 411-12 (= CorrBucer 3, pp. 252-54, Ep. 220).

[*Summary*]: Bucer and Capito have been lecturing daily on theology [at the Dominican monastery]. Bucer, however, lives a fair distance from the monastery [i.e. at St. Aurelia]. His other duties leave him short of time, and he cannot afford to lose time on commuting. The preachers therefore request that he be given accommodation closer to the monastery. His presence is also needed in discussions concerning the Anabaptists.
