

Letter 385: 19 April 1529, Strasbourg. Capito to Johannes Oecolampadius

Printed in BrOek 2, pp. 318-319, Ep. 655.

[*Summary*]: Capito is concerned about the church in Basel. They are sending Bonifacius [Wolfhart] to assist Oecolampadius. His own preference would have been to send Wolfhart to Solothurn, but the Strasbourgers were against it. Hedio will replace Wolfhart as Hebrew teacher. Writing in code [see also above, Epp. 309, 314], he refers to Ferdinand's pact with the Catholic Swiss cities. He has heard that there is much disagreement at the Diet of Speyer. There is talk of a colloquy on the Sacramentarian question and of restoring the old rites. He prays for a good outcome.
