

Letter 390: 13 May 1529, Strasbourg, Capito to Ulrich Zwingli

[*Summary*]: Capito uses coded language to express his fear of the machinations of the papists at the Diet of Speyer and his disappointment about the difficult negotiations for an alliance between Zurich and Strasbourg. He hopes that there will be no public unrest. The papists are trying to foster dissent.
