

Letter 399: 13 January 1530, Strasbourg, Capito to Joachim Vadianus

Printed in VadBr 4, pp. 201-202, Ep. 592.

[*Summary*]: Simpert [Schenk] vouches for Nicolaus [Guldi's] character. He has left the Anabaptist sect. They have sent Guldi to Zwingli [see below, Ep. 400] to ensure his safe journey to St. Gallen. Bucer, who does not generally favour such men, will write more. Capito asks Vadianus to aid Guldi in his search for a living. His conversion may serve as an example to others.
