

Letter 400: 13 January [1530], Strasbourg, Capito to Ulrich Zwingli

Printed in ZwBr 4, pp. 397-8, Ep. 957.

[*Summary*]: Capito is pleased that an alliance with Zurich has finally been concluded [on 5 January 1530]. There has been trouble with the Anabaptists. The bearer of this letter [Nicolaus Guldi, cf. above, Ep 399] or Bucer's letter will tell him more. Caspar Schwenckfeld has returned to Strasbourg and is engaged in fierce debates. The images will be removed from the churches, once the Strasbourg representatives have returned from [Zurich]. [Ulrich] Funk will tell Zwingli more. Capito is amazed that the people peacefully accepted such great changes.
