

Letter 409: [End of April 1530, Strasbourg] Capito, Martin Bucer and Jacob Sturm in the name of the City Council of Strasbourg to Charles V

[*Summary*]: The city explains its religious beliefs and practices and hopes for the convocation of a general council to settle the remaining questions. They ask the emperor to receive their statement graciously. It is not meant as an act of disobedience, but rather as an expression of their Christian belief.
