

Letter 411: 23 May 1530, Oldersum, Ulrich von Dornheim to Capito, Martin Bucer, Caspar Hedio, and Martin Cellarius.

[*Summary*]: Their letter adds to his pleasure of receiving a letter from Karlstadt. He has suffered persecution from Count [Enno I of East Friesland] but hopes to be aided by letters from [Philip] of Hesse and to benefit from the support of Strasbourg. He sends greetings to the community in Zurich and Basel, and to Ulrich Zwingli and [Johannes] Oecolampadius personally.
