

Letter 416: [15] July 1530, [Augsburg], Philip Melanchthon to Capito and Martin Bucer

Printed in CorrBucer 4, pp. 142-43, Ep. 313.

[*Summary*]: [Johannes] Brenz has reported to him about his conversation with Capito and Bucer. He cannot meet with them personally because he does not want to burden the Lutherans with the odium adhering to the Strasbourg teaching. Zwingli's [*Fidei ratio*] was inappropriate in tone and unfortunate in its timing. He wishes to settle their disagreement about the Eucharist, but invites them to submit their opinions to him in writing.
