

Letter 419: 22 July [1530], Augsburg, Capito and Martin Bucer to Ambrosius Blaurer

Printed in CorrBucer 4, pp. 157-9, Ep. 318.

[*Summary*]: There can be no doubt about the loyalty of [Konrad] Zwick, [a delegate to Augsburg]. They enclose a copy of their letter to Zwingli to save themselves repeating the report. Both Catholics and Lutherans are hostile toward the Strasbourgers. The bishops fear war. They send greetings to [Johannes] Zwick and the other brethren in Constance.
