

Letter 422: 31 August 1530, Zurich, Ulrich Zwingli to Capito

Printed in ZwBw 5, pp. 98-99, Ep. 1085.

[*Summary*]: He is glad that Capito has arrived safely in Strasbourg [i.e. from Augsburg]. He assumes he has already heard from Bucer about the interview with Melancthon [see above, Ep 420b]. If they had met earlier, they might have achieved consensus. Zwingli will write at length to Bucer. He will accept the Real Presence if it is stated that Christ's presence is not corporal, but spiritual and sacramental through faith, for Melancthon more or less conceded that. He has responded to Eck's violent denunciations [in the *Ad illustrissimos Germaniae principes Augustae congregatos de convitiis Eccii epistola* of 27 August]. It has been printed. Perhaps Christoph [Froschauer] has a copy with him. He asks for news from Strasbourg. The Anabaptists are causing problems in [Bremgarten]. He sends greetings to [Caspar] Hedio.
