

Letter 423: 3 September 1530, [Zurich], Capito to Friederich Myconius

[*Summary*]: Myconius had asked him to discuss the abolition of secret confession, but there were more important matters on the table. People must explore their conscience in private. This is what the Strasbourgers teach young people. The next step will be to teach the older generation. They hope to settle the Sacramentarian controversy. Capito asks Myconius to pray for concord. Bucer sends his greetings.
