

Letter 429a: 27 December 1530, Augsburg, The City Council of Augsburg to Martin Bucer and Capito.

[*Summary*]: The council thanks Capito and Bucer for the letter dated 13 December [not extant], in which they recommend Wolfgang Musculus and Bonifacius Wolfhart as preachers. Shortly afterwards the council sent Balthasar Langnauer, syndic of the city, to invite Musculus and to come to an agreement with him about the terms [cf. below, Ep. 431b]. They stand in need of preachers in Augsburg after they had to dismiss the evangelicals to satisfy the demands of Charles V during the Diet of Augsburg.
