

Letter 453: 10 October 1531, Strasbourg, Capito to Joachim Vadianus

Printed in VadBr 5, p. 21, Ep. 648.

[*Summary*]: He is pleased with the man [unidentified] recommended to him by Vadianus. He is free of the Anabaptist superstition. [Sabine Bader, cf. above, Ep. 451] will shortly move to Augsburg. He has been tutoring her and has written to the Augsburg council on her behalf [cf. above, Ep. 452]. He recommends a young man [unidentified], who wishes to take up residence in St. Gallen and perhaps take over the shop of his master. Bucer, Bedrot and the other co-ministers send greetings. Bucer has not yet completed his Latin apologia [of the Confessio Tetrapolitana, BDS 3, pp. 187-318].
