

Letter 466: 14 February 1532, [Augsburg], Capito to Joachim Vadianus

Printed in VadBr 5:42–43, Ep. 671.

[*Summary*]: Capito had plans to visit Vadianus in St Gallen, but was obliged to go to Augsburg instead. Indeed, he has no advice for Vadianus, who has given proof of his ability to deal with politics and religion. He hopes to visit St Gallen on another occasion. He has conceived great hopes from the meetings in Bern and Zurich. He recommends the bearer of the letter to Vadianus.
