

Letter 469a: 29 March [1532], Strasbourg, Capito and the Strasbourg Preachers to Johannes Schwebel

Printed in CorrBucer 7:403–5, Ep. 576.

[*Summary*]: Due to lack of time, the Strasbourg preachers will send their response to Schwebel's question [concerning his difficulties with Georg Pistor?] with the next courier. They will use as courier the pastor, about whom they have recently written [letter not extant], [Bartholomaeus Bauer?], from Wolfisheim, a small town in the territory of Duke Philip III of Hanau[-Lichtenberg]. He was compelled to give up his position on account of malicious remarks from his superior. The Strasbourg preachers recommend him for a position as pastor, provided that Schwebel first examine his beliefs and life style.
