

Letter 604: 18 April 1536, Strasbourg, Capito to Heinrich Bullinger

[*Summary*]: The meeting with the Lutherans will take place soon. Capito fears that Bullinger and his colleagues may not be able to participate on such short notice. He asks Bullinger to supply him with a letter showing his desire for concord without however discussing any doctrinal positions. He is too busy to write more. He sends his greetings to Bullinger's colleagues, to the council, and especially [Werner Beyel and Diethelm Roist].
