

Letter 629: 30 November 1536, Strasbourg, Capito to Heinrich Bullinger

Printed in HBBW 6:479–80, Ep. 920.

[*Summary*]: Capito recommends the [unidentified] bearer of the letter, an exile from Lucerne, now a citizen of Strasbourg. He asks Bullinger to aid him. Myconius will inform him of the details. Both Capito and Bucer gratefully acknowledge Bullinger's interest in the Concord. They will attempt to convey his good will to the theologians of Wittenberg and reassure them that it was not fear that kept Zurich from accepting the Wittenberg Articles. He sends his greetings to Leo [Jud], [Theodor] Bibliander, and [Conradus] Pellicanus.
